

The Budget Meeting of the West Fallowfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on November 11, 2019 in the township meeting room. Chairman Hershey called the meeting to order at 3:30 PM. Chairman Hershey, Anne Deffenderfer and Secretary Wheeler were in attendance. Richard Sprenkle was not in attendance.

The Board reviewed the requests of the Police Department for a new patrol vehicle, and 8 additional hours per month to be used by a part-time officer.

The Board reviewed the State Fund Budget.

The Board reviewed the General Fund Budget.

Duane Hershey made the motion to purchase the Tax Software for the Tax Collector in the amount of \$950.00. The motion was seconded by Anne Deffenderfer and passed.

The Board reviewed the general adjustments made in the General Fund Budget.

Discussion was given to the Police Department request for eight (8) additional hours per month to be used by the part-time officer. No action was taken on the request.

Discussion was given to the purchase of a patrol vehicle. The Board will allot \$13,314 in the police car category and will review the possibility in the spring for a lease/purchase of a new patrol vehicle if necessary.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30 PM.
